Minutes 6/23/16

Meeting for 6/23/2016

Called to order at 7:06 PM.

Present: Michael Mattingly, Jim Reuff, Robert Waterhouse and Damon Tempey.

Minutes moved and passed.

No additions to the agenda.

Jim talked about the TSP. Stated it is going slow and the contractor/engineer team is working on being satisfied with the goals and objectives which they are done with but need to be approved by the city and the state before moving on.

Jim is trying to get an invite to view drafts of plans early on line in regards to contract laying out what they are seeing (likely contractors from Portland) vs what might actually be happening in our city.

A big issue of focus is how many people are coming in and out of Lebanon vs people coming in, driving through and then moving on to their actual destination. This is to show a result of how much through traffic vs local traffic.

Big areas of focus include Oak/Airport Rd and surrounding intersections. Jim is hoping for first major meeting with them by end of July, though it was supposed to happen end of June and may be pushed back again.

It was agreed that Jim should feed our top priorities to the TSP and it was decided top priority will be bike/pedestrian corridors thought city. Major areas of focus should be schools, library, parks, downtown and other common public areas.

Recommended that board members review TSP maps from 2007 which are available online through city website to see areas of focus then and see if they should be adjusted to 2016 needs or if they are similar enough to what we want to peruse.

We need conclusive recommendation(s) to TSP by the time the meeting regarding the bike/pedestrian portion comes up which should be within the next 2-3 months.

Jim will ask city for larger scale maps than those we could see online to review at next meeting.

It was brought up that we should focus on “what we want and where we want it”.

Homework for all before next meeting is to review TSP maps online and bring recommendations/ideas for corridors to next meeting which will be on July 28.
