Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

This simple one story, hip roof, Queen Anne cottage has a square floor plan in front and a rectangular back wing with shed roof additions on each side. The hip roof front porch has decorative brackets between the turned posts. The front door, with panels and a single light, is centered between two one/one, double-hung windows. Two similar windows with cornice moldings are located on both side elevations. The house is clad with shiplap siding and corner boards. A corbeled red brick chimney is located in the center. The roof is covered with tar paper above the boxed cornice and undecorated frieze.
