

Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

The Reeves Building is located at midblock with a rectangular floor plan and a flat roof. The east facade features large store display windows above a low tiled wall. The entry is recessed at the south end of the facade and features aluminum frame glass doors. A cloth awning runs above the windows. At the parapet there are prefabricated panels of concrete and gravel with a large "Reeves" above the entry and a plain metal cornice at the top.
