

Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

The Mayer Building is a one-story structure which is typical of the Art Moderne style in its use of stuccoed concrete, curved corners, glass brick and molding at the parapet. On the south facade there are three metal sash multi-light casement windows on the east and a flat, curved awning with metal trim on the west. A metal plaque in the center next to the entry reads "F. D. Mayer Attorney at Law."

History

Frank D. Mayer was the son of Joel C. Mayer, president of the First National Bank of Lebanon. Frank attended the University of Oregon and lived in Lebanon most of his life.
