Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

This one-story Greek Revival house has a T-shaped floor plan and a lower wing added on the rear. Clad with shiplap siding and corner boards, vertical siding covers a new concrete foundation. There are abbreviated capitals below the frieze and steeply pitched gable roofs. The chimney has been removed. A low-pitched hip roof porch added along the front features exposed eaves, box columns on a low wall, and diagonal entry stairs at the southwest corner. There are paired one/one, double-hung windows below the shingled gable end at the center and a shed roof addition on the north.

Three one/one, double-hung windows are grouped together in the center of the south facade. There is a large multi-light sun porch on the left containing the entry door. The low east wing is an early addition with a steeply pitched gable and capitals below the frieze and projected verges. On the north facade there is a three-light door and several windows with a low, shallow, flat roof shed structure built across them. A flat roof garage has been built off the southeast corner.
