Art Boards Program



Call for artist proposals - The Strawberry Plaza Art Board Program provides a systematic process for the creation, selection and display of art on six (6) large-sized art panels (4' x 8') affixed to the north and south walls of Lebanon's Strawberry Plaza, the City's downtown art-themed pocket park.

This program is managed through the Lebanon Arts Commission. Selection of art work will occur using the *Official Entry Form*. All proposals will be created in miniature (in scale with the large boards) on the form. Multiple entries from the same artist are welcome. The Commission will act as a jury in selecting works for display. Once accepted, the artist will 90 days to complete the art board.

During the 12-month public display of each piece of art the public will be given the opportunity to participate in a silent auction for the eventual purchase of the piece (once it is retired from Strawberry Plaza). Proceeds from the sale will be split, with 50% shares distributed to the Lebanon Arts Commission Art Fund and the artist.



Interested artists are invited to pick up an *Official Entry Form* at Lebanon City Hall or go online and print the entry form on 11 x 17 paper.
