A Mascot by any other name what's in a name?

More correctly, what's in a mascot such as a brave on a galloping pony or a chieftain in full headdress?

The 17 May 2012 State Board of Education ruling that the Warrior must go as the Lebanon High mascot sent shock waves through the school and community. What's in a mascot? Possibly identity, more than 75 years of it to be exact.

Fast forward to the 2012-2013 school year. While Lebanon High School has until July 2017 to remove all vestiges of the Native American warrior, school still started on a tentative note. Students returned expecting to see no giant Warrior on the gym floor, no mounted brave next to the Fight Song, NOTHING! Instead, they spotted no apparent changes.

Confusing the issue was the State Board permitting the huge metal sculpture on the outside wall of the Bud Page Activity Center to remain. Their reason? It was deemed artwork and made no reference to the Warrior mascot.

With so much at stake in the midst of all this uncertainty, the mascot's eye turned inward, and introspection extended to serious soul searching. What is it to be a Warrior? The answer rings loud and clear.

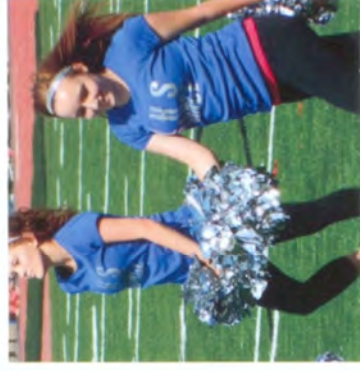

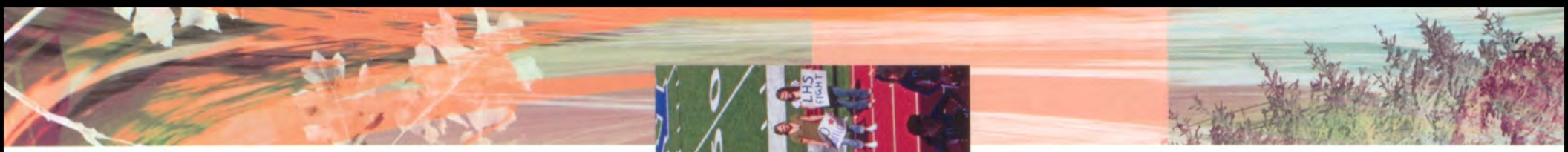

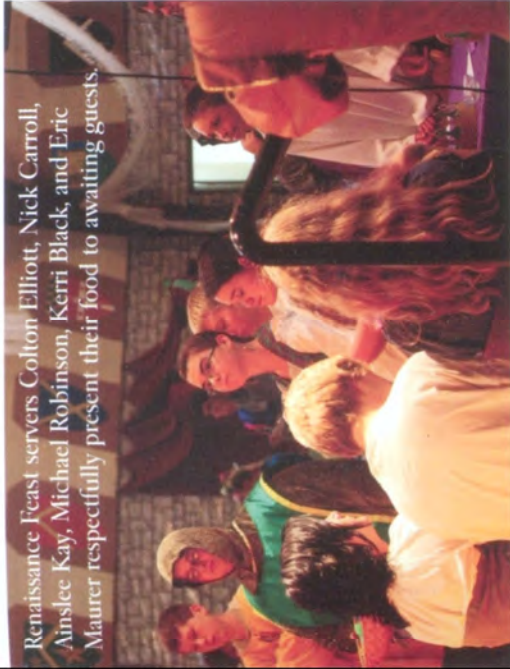

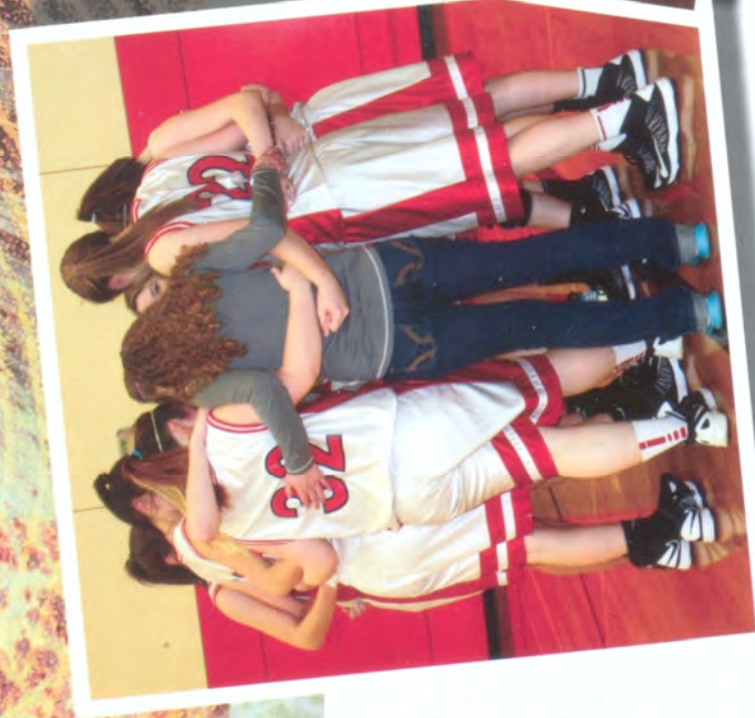

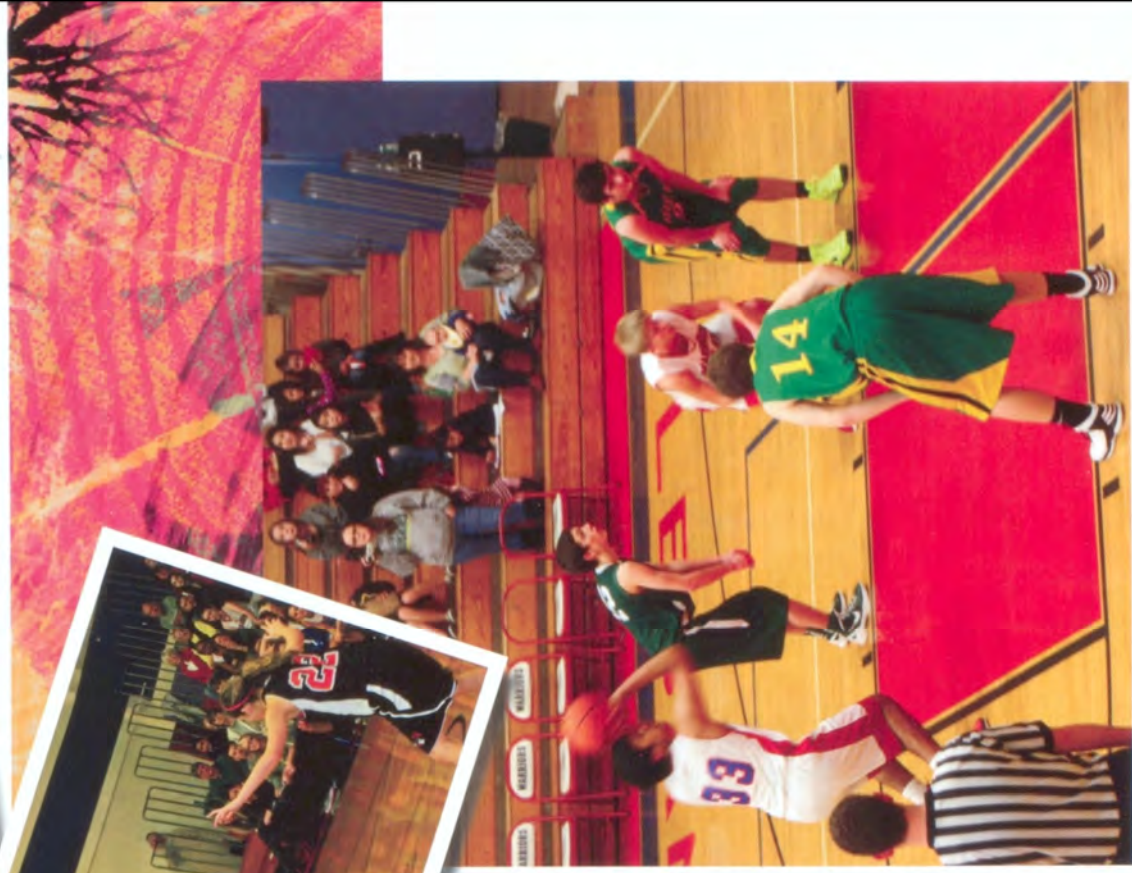

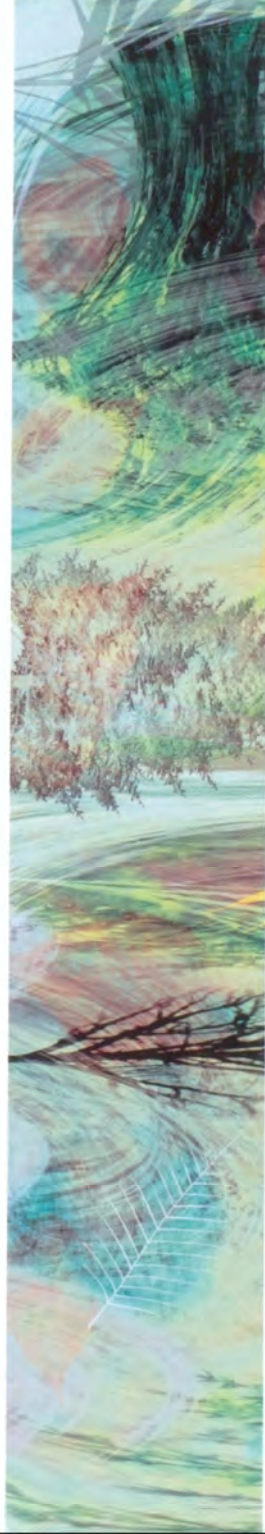

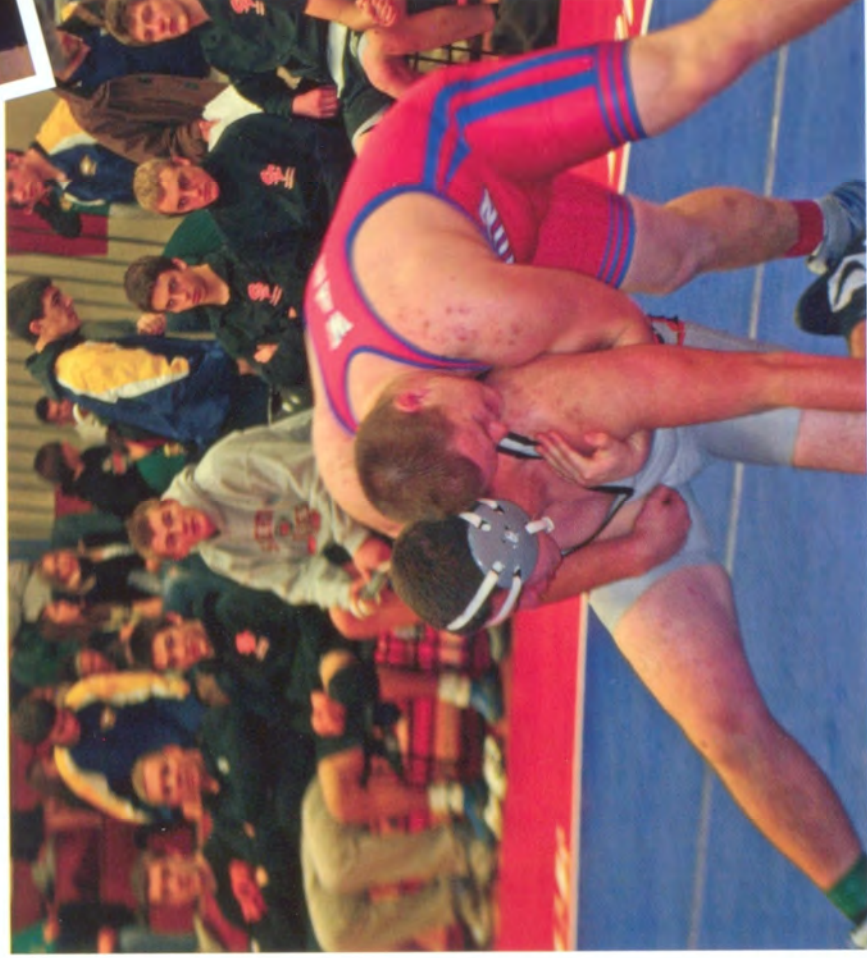
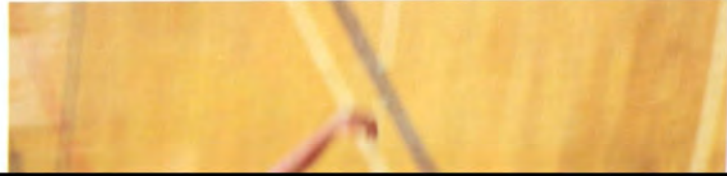

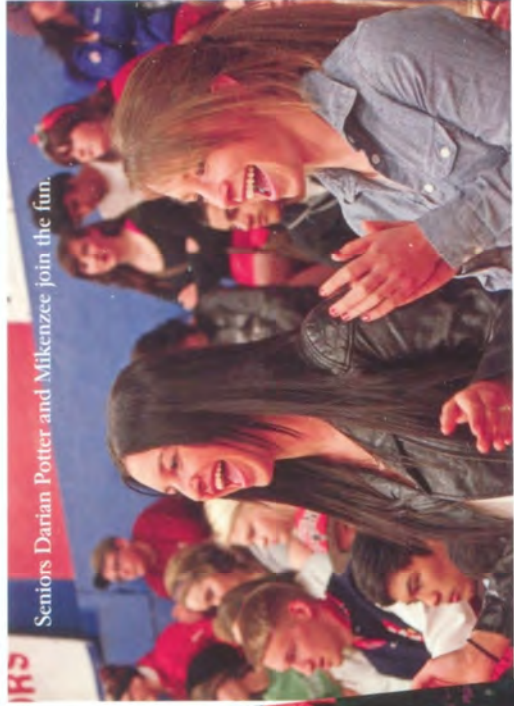

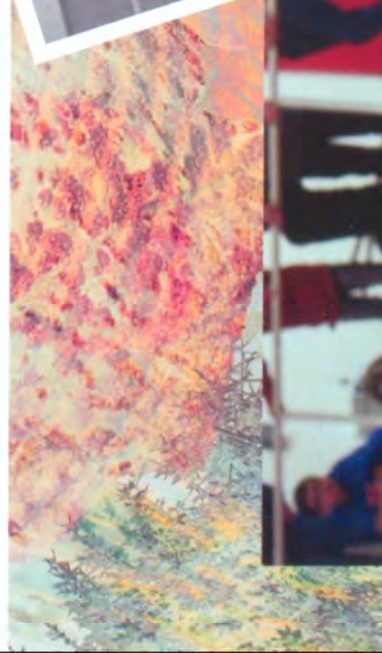

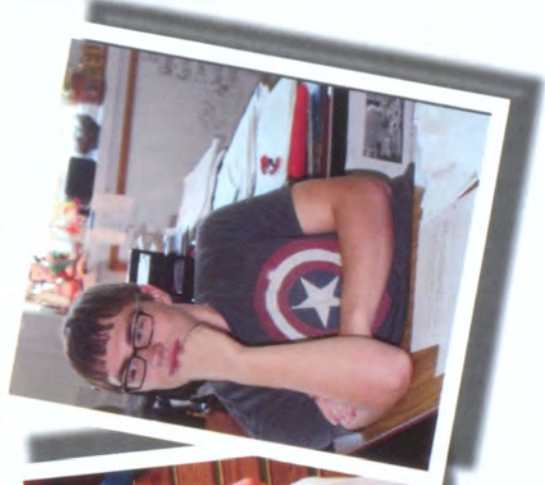

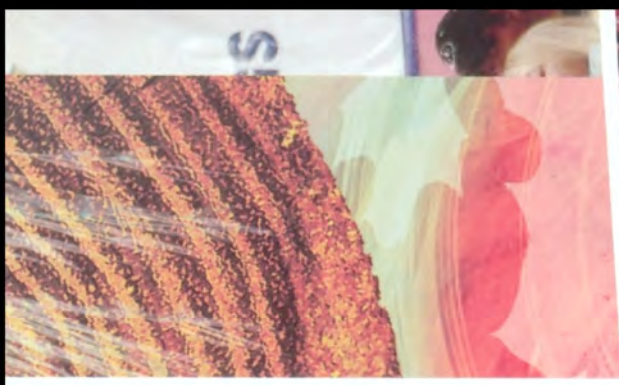
