

CONTRACTOR'S VERIFICATION OF HIGH-EFFICIENCY INTERIOR LIGHTING SYSTEMS

In accordance with ORSC Section N1107.2 and / or Table N1101.1(2) the owner, owner's authorized agent, or the general contractor must notify the Building Official in writing that the code requirements specified below have been met. The City of Lebanon Building Division has developed this written vertification process in order to facilitate consistent code compliance as effectively and effortlessly as possible.

ORSC N1107.2 High-Efficiency Interior Lighting Systems. A minimum of fifty (50) percent of the permanently installed lighting fixtures shall be installed with compact or linear fluorescent, or a lighting source that has a minimum efficacy of 40 lumens per input watt. Screw-in compact fluorescent lamps comply with this requirement.
