Physical description of property and statement of historical significance: This is a one-story corner lot commercial building with a rectangular floor plan and flat roof. The walls are stuccoed at the street level with glazed tiles at the ground. Above the windows and on all of the south facade the walls are clad with concrete and gravel panels. The three bays on the east facade and a rounded corner bay are divided by pilasters which step down in size above the windows. The southernmost bay contains two large plate glass windows set above the low wall. The other two bays contain identical storefronts with recessed entries in the center and large single-light display windows at each side. There is a service door on the south elevation and the parapet is stepped up on the southeast corner. There are signs above the stores and a cloth awning above the center bay. Keebler Brothers Construction built this structure to house a bakery on the south and to provide store rental space on Main Street.
