Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

Glazed terra cotta and decorative brick work are of note on this one-story masonry building. The storefront has new double aluminum frame glass doors in the center flanked by large single-light windows set above low glazed tile walls. The transom has been covered but raised and light colored terra cotta bricks still decorate the parapet.
