Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:	
This one and a half story Greek Revival house has steeply sloped gables and an L-shaped floor plan. The building is clad with shiplap siding with capitals on the corner boards. The front elevation features a porch on the right with a hip roof. The rear portion of the porch has been filled in with a double-hung window facing north and a semi-transparent fiberglass sheet forming a north wall to the porch. The front door has a corniced frame. The gable on the left faces the street and features two, one/one, double-hung windows with simple cornices on the first floor and another on the second floor. The south elevation contains two one/one, double-hung windows near the rear. The north elevation has the front porch on the left and to the right is a gable that is identical to the one facing the street, with two double-hung windows on the ground floor and another in	

the gable end. A corbeled brick chimney which once rose up the west wall is now in the

roof and clad with horizontal siding and corner boards. On the north there are square windows and a rear porch. The porch has square columns, a shed roof and a transparent
