Physical description of property and statement of historical significance:

This is a one and a half story Bungalow with a rectangular plan, a gable roof which parallels the street and bevel siding on the ground level separated from the shingled second floor by a belt cornice. The porch on the west side of the north elevation features a pedimented roof and two box columns with simple capitals. The bay window to the east features a multi-light transom. The center gable dormer has paired one/one light windows, brackets and a verge board. The west elevation features a large eight/one light, double-hung window flanked by narrower one/one light windows in the center of each floor. Thre are also square multi-light windows in the corners of the facade.
