



Mid-Valley Economic Indicators—Linn County

Linn County's economic recovery continued in August. The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in the county was 7.5 percent, down 0.9 percentage points from July. Total nonfarm employment (not seasonally adjusted) improved 1.7 percent from July, but is down 4.0 percent from last year. Finally, continued unemployment claims in Linn County (which counts individuals who were eligible and received benefits) were down from 3,839 in July to 2,634 in August.

Given the dual challenges of wildfires and COVID-19, this month indicators present a table and graph of the month. The table of the month lists the number of businesses and jobs in the Mid-Valley that were under evacuation orders in the past few weeks. The graph of the month depicts the percent of county populations with 0, 1-2, or 3+ risk factors related to COVID-19.



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

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Mid-Valley Economic Indicators—Salem MSA

The Salem MSA economic recovery continued in August. The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in the Salem MSA was 7.3 percent, down 2.4 percentage points from July. Total nonfarm employment (not seasonally adjusted) improved 0.9 percent from July, but is down 8.6 percent from last year. Finally, continued unemployment claims in the Salem MSA (which counts individuals who were eligible and received benefits) were down from 11,411 in July to 7,702 in August.

Given the dual challenges of wildfires and COVID-19, this month indicators present a table and graph of the month. The table of the month lists the number of businesses and jobs in the Mid-Valley that were under evacuation orders in the past few weeks. The graph of the month depicts the percent of county populations with 0, 1-2, or 3+ risk factors related to COVID-19.



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


Finally, continued unemployment claims in Linn County (which counts individuals who were eligible and received benefits) were down from 3,222 in July to 2,115 in August.


