

LINX Loop

The LINX Loop route runs Monday through Saturday, driving a north to south route with seven scheduled stops throughout the day. Riders can board the bus at any stop and when the schedule allows, the bus can depart from the route up to 3/4 of a mile within the City limits.

LINX Dial-A-Bus


The Lebanon Dial-a-Bus program provides curb-to-curb transportation for seniors, those with disabilities and the general public.

Schedule a ride by calling the Senior Center. Twenty-four hour notice is appreciated, but we will accommodate same day ride requests, as the schedule allows.

Rides are provided for a variety of purposes, including medical appointments, employment, shopping, education, banking and social events.

The Brownsville Connector service will make five round trips from Lebanon to Brownsville, each Tuesday and Friday.

We have three scheduled stops in Lebanon and Brownsville, with fixed departure times. Once riders are in Lebanon, they can get from point to point by calling the LINX Transit office at 541-258-4920 and/or following the LOOP schedule in Lebanon (back side of this brochure).

Guidelines:

- Look for the bus 10 minutes before and after your scheduled pick up time.
- When canceling a ride, call at least 30 minutes before your pick up time.
- Wear your seatbelt unless a doctor's note forbids it.
- We are not able to provide emergency transport.
- Animals are allowed when confined to a carrier with the exception of service animals. The ADA defines a service animal as any guide or signal animal trained to provide assistance to an individual with a disability. However, if the animal's behavior poses a direct threat to the health or safety of others, it will not be allowed on the bus.
- Children 12 years and under must be accompanied by an adult and use an approved safety seat per Oregon State law.
- Please be mindful of shopping purchases when using LINX Transport, so packages are manageable and can be transported in the shared bus space.
- Wheelchair/walker access is available.
- No smoking/eating/drinking on the bus.
- No unnecessary cell phone calls while on the bus.
- Follow code of conduct when riding LINX, posted on the bus and in Rider Guide.
